REGISTRATION	Full Registration participants are required to register (\$90). We have tried to keep this cost as low as possible to cover the venue hire and other costs in staging a large event. CLASS 1 CHAMPIONSHIP - FLOWERS IN THE VINES

To be staged on floor disc (Solver "Sugar Cane" colour) 90cm diameter, height unlimited. Fresh material to predominate. To be viewed and judged all around. Preconstructed work no more than 40% of the design.

1st Prize, \$300, 2nd Prize \$150, 3rd Prize \$100

CLASS 2 KALEIDOSCOPE OF COLOUR

Design on a Pedestal arrangement. Pedestal (white colour), height 100cm: top square 40 x40cm. To be viewed from the front. This arrangement may be staged 40% complete and finished on site. Refer to AFAA 2024 Manual page 86 for definition

CLASS 3 RAW ELEGANCE

Tapestry design, bench arrangement. Bench space 90cm deep x 75cm wide; refer to AFAA 2024 Manual.

SHOW RULES

All classes will be staged at The Vine Inn, 14 – 22 Murray Street, Nuriootpa, SA

- 1. Only one entry per person in each class. Entries may be restricted in number according to venue space. Late entries may be considered at discretion of Show Committee.
- 2. Exhibits must be the individual competitor's own work. Plagiarised designs will be down pointed in the judging process.
- 3. Entries close 31 March 2025. All entries are to be made on official Registration Form by email or post by this date.
- 4. All bench tables covered with dark green cloth. All entries to be judged from front and sides, unless stated otherwise in the Schedule.
- 5. Fresh horticultural material MUST predominate over all other components of exhibit unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. Use of artificial material is prohibited in any exhibit.
- 6. Fresh horticultural material MUST remain turgid for duration of Show.
- 7. Exhibits may not be changed after Judging. The Judge's decision is final. Chief Adjudicator for the Convention will be **Alethia Quick OAM**.
- 8. Competitors unable to fulfil their ENTRY commitments must notify the Show Secretary: Joy Johnson: Mobile 0418 895 438
- 9. Painted, artificially coloured horticultural material may be used with discretion. No aerosol painting allowed inside venue.
- 10. Do not converse with other competitors during staging. Keep your own equipment within your allotted areas. Clean up and leave area once staging is finished.
- 11. No photographs or electronic transmission allowed until after Awards announced. Images remain the property of AFAA.
- 12. Staging times include cleaning up your area. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to cause no water damage or any other damage to venue.
- 13. No assistance may be given to the exhibitor in preparation or construction of exhibit except at the discretion of Stewards, e.g. to assist with heavy object.
- 14. Judging will take place by accredited AFAA Judges in accordance with AFAA 2024 Manual.
- 15. Dismantling between 3:00 5:00pm Friday 16 May 2025. Any items not removed by 5.00pm Friday 16 May 2025, will be disposed of by the organisers.
